Now that you are a son or daughter of God the Father, you know that you were made in His image. In lesson 1 of part 4 we learned that God made people to love. He created man with value and destiny. In Christ all of these important parts are restored. Whatever has happened in your past, God restores the original picture.

On not look any longer at what has gone wrong, but focus on what God has for you!

a. We Belong, Unconditional Love

As far as our spirits go, we are already (in this world) just like Jesus. Our new spirit, or also known as our new man, which we receive when we accept Jesus' sacrifice, is created in true holiness and righteousness. Spiritual growth does not exist, strictly speaking; our spirit cannot be more holy than it already is. We are however able to grow in discovering and grasping who God is, who we are and what we have received through Christ. The Bible calls this renewing of the mind. We start to live increasingly more like Jesus the more we grasp who we already are in Him!

b. Our Value is Restored

Jesus has made us valuable again, despite shame, rejection and disappointment in our old lives. What happened with our sin?

1 John 2:12

Why are we now worthy?

Rom 3:22-24 1

In this verse we see that we are forgiven but that if we do fall short again, we have an advocate with the Father, namely Jesus, the righteous one.



1 John 2:1

You are now His child, just as it is in the natural between a father and his son or daughter. If one day things do not go well, you remain His child. God is faithful and that which He has started, He will not let go. Even when we let go, He will not. Because you belong now! You are completely worth it.

c. Equipped

In a life with Jesus, our purpose for living will become clear. Jesus made us with a purpose and He will do everything in His power to bring you to the place where you fulfill that purpose. Start looking for God today and asking Him to tell you what He thinks of your future. Ask Him to lead you to the place He wants you to be.

2 Cor 3:4-6

We read here that it is God's work and that it is He who makes us able.

In our daily lives we know too well what we need to do when, for example, our laptop is not working properly. You go to the shop and let the experts from the factory take a look at it. They are specialists in getting the computer to work. That is how it is with you and God. God specializes in showing us exactly for what we were made. The first is loving and giving. In our work this is a very important factor. God is a giver. There is something in us which we can give to others. For example, knowledge, something we enjoy making or restoring, doing odd jobs for others, giving encouragement and so the list goes on. When you start to learn to give you often get a feeling of satisfaction. Giving love and serving others is part of God's character and therefore also ours.

The Inheritance of Abraham

Abraham was called a friend of God. He was also considered righteous by God because he was dependent upon God and trusted Him. Each time that God spoke to Abraham, Abraham believed God. This resulted in God promising Abraham many blessings. Some of these promises were fulfilled during Abraham's lifetime, others were fulfilled much later.

This means than when you start to believe, the blessing will come in your life. God's favor! But this blessing is not only for you, it extends to your family.


