

HEARING AND DOING THE WORD - 1

Disciple 2 | principle 26

Read the following scriptures and answer the related questions.

John 9:1-17

Matt 19:16-30

Luke 9:10-17

John 14:21-24



What do you learn from the stories about doing what Jesus says to do?

Read the four stories and write down to whom Jesus says something and what He says.

What are the consequences of doing what Jesus says?

Say something about the people to whom Jesus speaks. What do you know about their life?

Did people immediately do what Jesus said to them to do?

What is the response of the people? Are they happy, critical, angry, excited? Why?

Read the story from John 9 once more and write down the responses of all the people.

Does Jesus apply any conditions to receiving his love?

Read John 14 once more and look at the conditions to receiving the love and presence of Jesus. Why do they decide to do what Jesus asks?

Does Jesus choose the people or do they choose Him?

Is it difficult for the people to carry out the commands of Jesus? If yes, why, if not, why not?

Read the story from John 14 again and apply it to your own life.

Ask yourself four questions:

Is there a word from God for me personally in this text?

Is there a promise from the Father for my life?

Does Jesus ask me to do anything?

Decide to act upon this and ask Jesus to help you with this.
