Read the following scriptures and answer the related

questions. Acts 1:12-14, Acts 2:42, Acts 4:23-31 Acts 6:3-6

Acts 8:17, Acts 16:18, Acts 28:8

What do you learn about prayer in these stories?

Read the stories and write down what you learn about how the disciples pray. What do you know about the lives of those praying?

What are the results of prayer in these stories?

Acts describes how the apostles continue without the physical presence of Jesus, but with the Holy Spirit. Do you see a difference in how Jesus prayed and how the apostles prayed? You will need to take a look at some of the stories from the Gospels.

In which way and to whom is something said in prayer?

Read all the passages again and write down for yourself how and what is prayed. To whom are they talking, God, satan or someone else? Is it difficult for the people to carry out Jesus' commands? If yes; why, if not; why not?

Jesus spoke about the importance of prayer, do you want to learn that too?

Read the story from Luke 11:1-13 and now apply it to your own life.

Ask yourself four questions:



Is there a word from God for me personally in this text? Is there a promise from the Father for my life? Does Jesus ask me to do anything? Decide to act upon this and ask Jesus to help you with this.

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
