Read the five chapters and write down the circumstances of Jesus and His disciples. Also write down what Jesus says about peace.

Read John 20. Following His death, Jesus suddenly reappears. What does Jesus mean by the peace He is talking about at this moment in time?

Peace comes through the Kingdom of God and His righteousness. Describe how you experience this peace in your personal life. Is this peace different from when you did not know Jesus Christ as your King?

**What do you learn from Jesus, the Prince of Peace, for your own life?**

Does Jesus ask me to do anything?
