



EXERCISE:

Read through the four Bible texts and answer the four related questions.

Acts 1:1-8

Acts 13:1-12

Luke 9:1-6, Luke 10:1-11

Matt 28:16-20

Which command does Jesus give to His disciples/apostles?

Read the four stories and write down what you learn about the command Jesus gives and the principles Jesus taught us about sending out disciples.

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What is the result of the disciples/apostles being sent out?

In Luke we see that the apostles are given the task of being sent out. In Acts 13:1-12 we read what the results are. Describe these. Do the results match what Jesus said in Matt 28:16-20?

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Which message are the disciples/apostles to bring?

In Acts 1:1-8 we read how Jesus chooses his disciples and gives them clear instructions about the message which they are to preach. Write this process down once again.

Is there anything else written in Acts 1 which is important?

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What is a man of peace?

What is meant by Jesus in Luke 10:1-10 by a man of peace? Describe whom the disciples are to look out for in the village. What is their task regarding this?

Jesus speaks about the importance of making disciples. Do you want to learn this?

Read the story of the sower once more in Matt 28:16-20 and apply it to your own heart.

Ask yourself four questions:

Is there a word from God for me personally in this text?

Is there a promise from the Father for my life?

Does Jesus ask me to do anything?

Decide to act upon this and ask Jesus to help you with this.
