Study the life and “heart” of Paul.

Acts 7:54-60

chapter Acts 9, 11:19-30

chapters Acts 13,14, 16,17

chapters Acts 21,22,23

What can you learn from Paul?

Read the four stories and describe what the stories tell us about who Paul was before and after his encounter with God on the road to Damascus?

What do we learn from Paul as he sets about preaching? Take note of how he deals with people and how he handles disappointments.

What do we learn from Paul when he is captured?

Which lesson is it that the early Christians need to learn?

What can you learn from Paul for your own life?

Acts 14:21,22 and 2 Cor 1:3-10 Read Jesus’ instructions. Now apply it to your own life.

Ask yourself four questions:

Is there a word from God for me personally in this text?

Is there a promise from the Father for my life?

Does Jesus ask me to do anything?

Decide to act upon this and ask Jesus to help you with this.
